

STEPS TO SUCCESS:

Taking your GED Test with West Kern Adult Education



Official GED exams are free of cost to eligible WKAEN students.

Step 1

Enroll with West Kern Adult Education's GED Program. Once enrolled, you will be required to complete a minimum of 12 hours for each subject and be physically present for at least one class per 12-hour period.

Step 2

Your instructor will let you know when it is time for you to take the official GED exam. This decision is based on how many hours you've been in class and your post-test scores.

Step 3

To schedule your test, please call 661-745-4582 and our Testing Center will give you a scheduled date and time for your exam.

Step 4

It's testing time! Ensure you arrive **15** minutes early for your exam with a valid state-issued Identification card & proof of residency, if the form of identification brought does not prove you are a resident of California.

If you cannot make it, you must give 48 hours notice by calling 661-745-4315 or cancelling your appointment online through MyGED portal. Students who fail to show up for their appointment or are more than 15 minutes late will lose one of their two FREE attempts with West Kern Adult Education.

**Students will only receive 2 free exam attempts. If a student fails their first attempt they must wait 12 days and score a 70% or higher on the practice exam.*



GED Exam Breakdown

LANGUAGE ARTS

Time allotted:

155 minutes

10 minute break between parts 2 and 3

45 minutes for the written essay

Format will be divided in 3 sections with multiple choice and other question types such as drag and drop, select an area, and drop down. Additionally, there will be 1 written essay (extended response).

MATH

Time allotted:

120 minutes

Short break between parts

Format will be divided in 2 sections with multiple choice and other question types such as drag and drop, select an area and drop down as well as access to a calculator during the second part. You will have access to a reference sheet and math formula sheet.

SCIENCE

Time allotted:

95 minutes

No breaks

Multiple choice test with other question types such as drag and drop, select an area, and drop down. Additionally, there will be access to a calculator and calculator reference sheet.

SOCIAL STUDIES

Time allotted:

75 minutes

No breaks

Multiple choice test with other question types such as drag and drop, select an area, and drop down. Additionally, there will be access to a calculator and calculator reference sheet.
